Application Instructions:

The National Summer Transportation Institute (NSTI) is a two-week program for high school students focusing on the U.S. Transportation System. The camp is available to rising 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th graders (in one of these grades for the academic year 2023-2024). There is no charge for attendance for students admitted to the camp.

Admission is competitive. Please submit required admissions application documents to Dr. Doug Martin marti223@nsuok.edu. Applications will be accepted until May 5.

Application Documents Must include:

- 1) A completed Application Form (attached)
- 2) An official transcript showing students' cumulative GPA and verifying completion of, or current enrollment in, pre-algebra or Algebra I.
- 3) A letter of recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor.
- 4) A brief statement, one or two short paragraphs, describing why the applicant is interested in participating in the NSTI and how participation supports their career goals.
