The camp is available to rising 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th graders (in one of these grades for the academic year 2023-2024). There is no charge for attendance for students admitted to the camp.

Admission is competitive. Please submit required admissions application documents to Dr. Doug Martin marti223@nsuok.edu. Applications will be accepted until May 5.

Application Documents Must include:

- 1) A completed Application Form (attached)
- 2) An official transcript showing students' cumulative GPA and verifying completion of, or current enrollment in, pre-algebra or Algebra I.
- 3) A letter of recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor.
- 4) A brief statement, one or two short paragraphs, describing why the applicant is interested in participating in the NSTI and how participation supports their career goals.
