The certificate in Business Analytics introduces students to the fundamental tools of business analytics. This program prepares students to utilize these tools in making informed decisions in their workplaces. The curriculum develops the student's ability to work effectively with technicians, system users, and managerial decision-makers; to become mentally disciplined and to communicate data and ideas graphically, orally, and in writing.
